Decide how to fundraise

There are lots of ways to fundraise, have lots of fun and make good things happen:

Sales:

Hold a car boot, cake, craft, book or plant sale.

Social events:

Fetes, treasure hunts, dinner dances, concerts, dog or car show, BBQ, bingo, themed parties or your favourite entertainment as a fundraiser

Sports and tournaments:

Charity football, rugby or netball matches, enter a race or organise an exercise marathon for your school, college or workplace.

Something more daring:

Shave your head, climb a mountain or do something you've always wanted to do like skydiving!

How to Get Organised



Date

When deciding your date, bear in mind other events nearby and bank holidays. Ensure you have enough time to plan and prepare.

Location

Will you hold it at home or your local centre? Does the venue need to be booked? Think about parking and access.

Budget setting

Anything that might need to be bought or donated to hold your event. Consider how many tickets you need to sell and at what price. Try to stick to your budget to maximise fundraising.

How to fundraise

You could hold an auction, sell raffle tickets or ask for sponsorship.

Communicating your event

Make sure you let everyone know it is in aid of Friends of Tewkesbury Hospital and display the charity no. on all publicity, entry tickets and raffle tickets.

Help on the day

Who will you need? Possibly friends, family, work colleagues, to help set up, spread the word or ask for donations on the day.





Food Hygiene

See food.gov.uk for information about hygiene and allergies. Ensure any professional caterers have certificates and insurance.

Collections

You may need a permit from your local council if you are collecting donations in the streets. If on private property you will need the landowner's permission. All collectors must be over 16.

Contractors

Ensure all contractors have insurance, health and safety certificates and public liability insurance.

Insurance and Event Notices

You will need to arrange your own public liability insurance for events. Ask your council if you need a temporary event notice.

Raffles

Check the latest information at gamblingcommisison.gov.uk.

Risk Assessment

Conduct prior to your event to ensure you have planned for safety and risks, see hse.gov.uk for further information.
